Submission Guidelines

"Politicheskaia nauka" accepts contributions in the following genres: research articles, review articles, review essays, book reviews, abstracts, translations. The issues of "Politicheskaia nauka" are thematic, so the contents of the manuscripts must correspond to the subjects of the issues.

The manuscripts may be submitted in a printed form or electronically in Microsoft Word or RTF format. They should be in standard 14-point type with 1.5 lines spacing. The maximum length for article submissions is twenty-four pages with 1.5 lines spacing, or 5,400 words; for book reviews, 3,200 words.

If the manuscript includes diagrams, the authors should send original files in .xls or .xlsx format which should contain the data of the diagrams in the manuscript and enable editing them. Pictures and schemes should be submitted it .ppt, .pptx, or JPEG format; please send them as separate files along with your manuscript. All the text, as well as tables, diagrams, schemes, and pictures in the manuscript, must be black-and-white. Pictures, diagrams, schemes, tables and other elements taken from the other authors' publications, must not violate the copyright law and must always be accompanied by citations to their primary source.

The list of sources should be placed at the end of the manuscript. The sources should be listed in an alphabetical order without numbering, first Russian sources, then the foreign ones. The references in the list should follow the rules of the Institute of Scientific Information for Social Sciences and the bibliographical standard of the Russian Federation (GOST R 7.0.5-2008). Citations in the text should be in square brackets and include the name of the author, the year of the publication, and page number. Footnotes with text comments are also possible.

The manuscript should be accompanied by an annotation, in Russian and English, no longer than 50–100 words. The authors must provide their full name, place of work, position and contacts. This information is published in the List of Contributors.

All articles considered by the editors to have potential for publication will be subject to anonymous peer review by scholars in the field. Once an article has been evaluated it may be accepted, sent to the author for revision and resubmission, or rejected. The publication is free of charge.
